Subject: Annual Elements of Manufacturing Basics Self-Assessment	

**PURPOSE:**

MACI is required by its customers to conduct Chrysler’s “Elements Of Manufacturing Basics” Annual Self-Assessment. Part of this requirement is that all MACI suppliers must also conduct the Annual Self-Assessment. Therefore, MACI must receive and maintain a record of this Annual Self-Assessment from all suppliers.

**SCOPE:**

The organization shall conduct an internal quality audit at least once per year. As a part of the internal quality audit, the organization shall perform an annual self-assessment to ensure their Quality Management System is in compliance with the Objectives, Example Metrics and Support Mechanisms defined in Chrysler’s document “Elements of Manufacturing Basics”. This self-assessment is mandatory, beginning with the organization’s first internal audit occurring on or after 7 January 2008.

**CONTENT:**

The document is available through the Chrysler Global Supplier Portal via the “Quality Management Systems Information” page, and on MACI’s Supplier Central website. This self-assessment may be performed as part of an internal quality audit or separately. The self-assessment requirement also applies to the organization’s supply base (all suppliers). The organization (and all suppliers) shall maintain records of this self-assessment including any corrective actions required for compliance.

To meet this requirement, submit the **Annual Elements of Manufacturing Basics Compliance Form QA-SM-23-F1** annually.
